A typical evaluation of Teacher Practice will consist of one ANNOUNCED full period observation (or two twenty minute instructional blocks) **and** 3-5 UNANNOUNCED 15 minute mini-observations (or drop-ins) throughout the course of the Summative Year. The unannounced drop-in visits can occur at any point AFTER the EEP approval meeting with the evaluator and/or building administrator. If an evaluator needs to collect additional evidence in a domain and/or component, they may exceed the 5 unannounced drop-in observations.
